Restaurants in Michigan are a driving force in the state's economy. Their sales generate tremendous tax revenues. They provide jobs and build careers for thousands of people. In 2012, Michigan's restaurants are projected to register **\$12.6 billion** in sales.



Every \$1 spent in Michigan's restaurants generates an additional **\$0.99** in sales for the state economy.



In 2010, there were **16,069** eating and drinking places in Michigan.



Every extra \$1 million spent in Michigan's restaurants generates an additional **30.7** jobs in the state.
